### The anatomical centurio Greaves of Marcus Favonius Facilis-centurio Legio XX

These anatomical centurion Greaves are made from our Legion IIII master blacksmith be a private ordering from a centurion colleague.

All the muscles around the knee are well expressed. Shinbone is released smoothly, without sharp edge.

Please pay attention on the way how the greaves is depicted. Greaves were made possible closest to the original of the fresco picture. You can see how swollen border runs along the edge.
