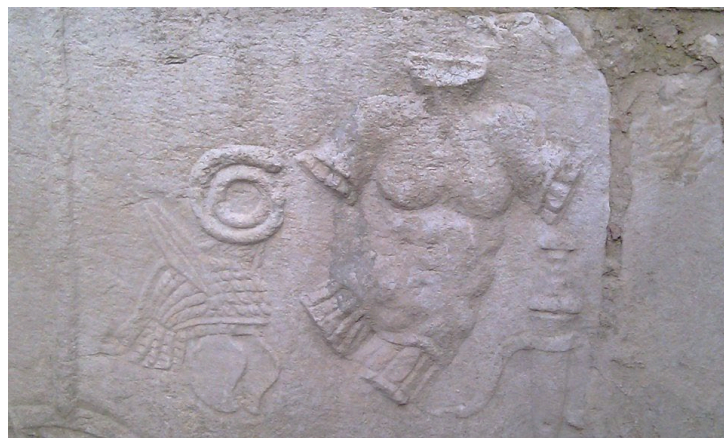


Helmet from Mausoleum of centurio Marcus Marcellus Pacius of Legio III Scythica Citadel fortified monastic –Italy CAMPANIA

My Replica of a helmet (cavalry model) depicted together with cuirass musculata and gladius mainz model (I guess) from Mausoleum of centurio Marcus Marcellus Pacius of Legio III Scythica of Citadel fortified monastic – Italy CAMPANIA. The fresco is supposed to be from a funeral from the Flavius period. The only inscription named here refers to centurio Marcus Marcellus Pacius of Legio III Scythica. So, at this stage, I suppose this is his one military equipment. Here the feathers are only 2 on both sides of the helmet. It is not clear with what the comb is made of. In my replica we have chosen horsehair. Of course, anyone who wants can make it with a feather model comb!



In roman reenactment practice this helmet crest model is mainly used for Optio. But it is possible I guess in the Roman army, centurions also have used this parallel option model crest helmet. I am also a supporter of the transversal centurion crest but in this case I have the opportunity for interpretation.
