

3/4 th century plate and buckle from Igoumenitsa Museum Greece

5. Bronze buckle. 3rd - 5th cent. AD. Egnatia Odos - Neochori.

All elements are forged by hand. The plate is made of a curved brass plate which is bent into a two. I've tried to get closer to the original.
