

## Medallions

Depiction images of ancient deities from Olympus in their Roman version on medallions and other ornaments were very popular in antiquity and not only then even now in ancient reconstructions this is a popular practice. These here Neptune and Mars are from the classical roman imperial period .



Neptune standing facing, head left, naked except for cloak draped behind him & over both arms, holding small dolphin in right hand & vertical trident in left. The dimensions of Neptune medallion is around 34mm.,16,2 g.



I chose Neptune because in the modern reenactment there is many colleagues who belong to the so-called "blue sctarii" or naval legions.

Mars is the classic Roman god of war and I have chosen one of the earliest images used by imp. Claudius - Bareheaded and draped bust left / Mars, barefoot, but wearing full military outfit, advancing left, holding spear in outstretched right hand and round shield in left. The dimensions of Mars medallion is around 37mm.,17,3 g.
