

Rosettes suitable for an early classical period and Hellenistic antique equipment helmets and armor.

This type of rosettes are very suitable for several models of armor, shields and helmets because of their resemblance with the museum exponents. These are the rosettes designed for armor decoration from Philippe Macedonian's funeral in Virginia ,decorated with floral motifs (flowers).



I produced a great variety of rosettes of this model for the needs of our club, of different diameters and by different archeology. The diameter starts from 35 mm. on till the smallest 20 mm.



The same rosettes can be seen on this Thracian / Macedonian helmet from Pletena, Blagoevgrad (Hellenistic epoch). Exposed in National Museum of History Sofia.



Matrix form necessary for forging them. Rosettes are knocked from a sheet of brass. These are the same rosettes but already designed for the Greek type of shield aspis.
